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## **Introduction:**

"Strategic leadership" is the ability of individuals to lead a successful process of decision making as for the vision, missions and strategy of a given organization and to draw the action-plan to fulfill them.

Strategic leadership, as a characteristic of a person and as an organizational process, provides practices that are crucial for the organization to remain relevant, competitive and successful. It becomes vital in adapting to changes in technology, social climate, economic factors, inner and outer political issues etc.

Strategic leadership balances a focused analytical perspective with the human dimension of strategy making. It is important to engage the entire organization in a strategic dialogue in order to lay the foundations for building a winning team that can define, commit, adjust and adapt its strategy to challenges ahead and changes needed.

## **The seminar:**

Four of the top professors, scholars and consultants in the field of strategy making, leadership, management and technology teamed up to provide a seminar for leaders on the subject of strategic leadership.

The two days seminar, holding four sessions, each led by one of the experts and supported by the others, becomes a source of knowledge, practice and exchange of views for its participants.

Each of the experts turns the spotlight to a different angle of the entire process and sheds light on aspects that are milestones on the way to success. These millstones include decision making, personal leadership, knowledge management and technological leadership.



**The benefits:**

1. The participants will experience and practice different points of view brought by the top experts.
2. The participants will be able to bring their own experiences and discuss them with the small practice teams.

**The seminar's duration:**

1. The seminar lasts two full consecutive days 09:00-17:00.
2. The seminar is assembled from four sessions of 4 hours each.
3. Each session is divided into two parts, starting with expert knowledge presented by one of the experts, followed by discussions in teams led by the four experts.
4. The audience should not exceed 40 participants.
